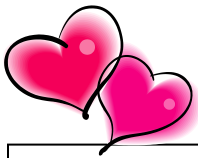

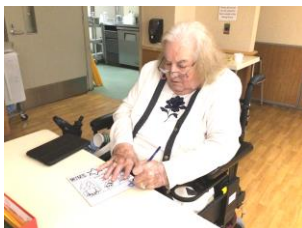

What better way to show the community how much fun we have at the Lodge? In total, 13 residents helped us build this beautiful Menorah which was on display during Hannukah.

"Hillel Lodge recreation staff chose a Menorah theme that encompassed the spirit and resilience of the residents and staff here at the lodge. One of our popular activities that many residents enjoy is bingo. Each week the residents look forward to gathering with friends to play a light-hearted game of bingo. The pandemic has been difficult on everyone, especially those in long term care homes but we have worked hard to keep spirits high by continuing our programming with special attention to social distancing and infection control. The residents of our home benefit so much from bingo that when we approached them with the idea of building a bingo Menorah, they were excited to participate in this JET community contest.

Veronica Benedek (a resident of Hillel Lodge) described Bingo as, "Bingo is 30 minutes of just having fun. I do not worry about anything else; it is not for the education or work; it is just to have a good time. I can just play the bingo and I will have fun and sometimes I will laugh. I also help my friend (Judith) to play so we can have fun together. The news is sometimes bad now so we play games and it helps us to not worry. Everybody who plays bingo can have a good time together."
