Donations to a charity can also be structured in many different ways:

Residual Bequest: A gift of all or a percentage of whatever remains after all taxes, liabilities, administrative expenses and specific bequests have been paid. The greatest advantage of this bequest is that, as your estate increases or decreases in value over time, your donation changes in the same way.

Specific Bequest - The Hillel Lodge Long-Term Care Foundation receives a set amount of money or a percentage of the value of the estate.

Contingent Bequest: Your donation is modified or takes effect based on circumstances. For example, you direct the Foundation to receive a portion of your estate if other beneficiaries do not survive you.
