To all the mothers, whether past, present, or soon to be moms, may your day be filled with love, joy, and laughter.

Shavuot (Feast of Weeks) commemorates the revelation of the Torah on Mt. Sinai to the Jewish people, and occurs on the 50th day after the 49 days of counting the Omer.

Shavuot is one of the three biblically based pilgrimage holidays known as the shalosh regalim. It is associated with the grain harvest in the Torah.

Shavuot is observed by abstaining from work and attending synagogue services. It is also customary to study Torah all night; this practice is called Tikkun Leil Shavuot.



Yom Yerushalayim (Jerusalem Day) begins at sundown on Thursday, May 18, 2023 and ends at nightfall on Friday, May 19, 2023.

It commemorates the reunification of Jerusalem under Jewish sovereignty in 1967. It is celebrated on the 28th day of Iyar (six weeks after the Passover seder, one week before the eve of Shavuot).


